Module 2: Engaging Pupils in Learning

Week: 1: Module Audit

Key events/meetings this week:

ECTs have the first face to face training session with their facilitator this week. Please ensure that you know when and where this session is. If you have any problems, please ensure that you speak to your mentor and Induction Tutor. It is important that you inform your facilitator if you can't attend and then watch the recording from UCL that will be put on the platform (in the training session recordings section in the Year 1 area) by the end of the week.

Mentors, whilst you do not have a meeting with your facilitator, you do have self study material to read prior to your mentor meeting. Part 1 of the document focuses on developing understanding of learning conversations. Part 2 is an introduction to the module content for Module 2. You should spend approximately 1 hour on each section.

ECT Self Study Actions (to be completed prior to your mentor meeting):

This week you don't have any self-study materials to read as you have a training session with your facilitator instead. You may, however, wish to complete the module audit prior to your mentor meeting. Please do discuss this with your mentor.

Mentor Meeting Key Actions:

The module audit is designed to be completed within the allotted mentor meeting time. You may choose to agree with your mentee that they will complete the audit in advance of the meeting; in which case, the meeting can be truncated to reflect this.

Ask your ECT to talk you through their audit and to explain the reasoning behind each self-assessment.

Agree with your ECT how you will use the outcomes from the audit to inform your use of the programme materials for the remainder of this module. Are there some areas which will need a greater, or lesser, focus? Using the Summary Module Guide highlight, together, any areas to which you will give particular focus.

Additional Information:

The 'End of Module 1 Assessment' form should be completed by both ECTs and mentors by the end of this week (November 5th). A record will be saved with UCL but you may wish to print your responses off as evidence for your Induction Tutor to sign off in December alongside Module 2.

ECTs and Mentors, remember to download the Module 2 Progress and Learning log (found in your respective gateways).

A reminder: Mentors and ECTs, please be aware that if you didn't provide the DfE with all the information they required you will need to return to the link and complete this. You **must** provide your Teacher Reference Number (TRN). For ECTs, this will be a 7-digit number starting with 20. For mentors, the first two digits will represent the year you commenced teacher training. If you can not locate this number, please speak to your Principal's PA or your Business Manager in the first instance. Your Induction Tutor will be able to inform you if you are unsure whether you need to provide more information.
